



Brighton Primary School Bring Your Own Device iPad program 2017-Quick Questions Guide

Who participates in the program?

Students in grade 5 and 6.

When does it start?

Term 1 2017

What device is required?

An Apple iPad Air or iPad Mini with the following capabilities:

- Runs **the most up-to-date** apple ios software
- Enough **available memory** to create a range of media and download required apps
- Working **camera**

As base model purchase we recommend:

iPad mini 2, 32GB, wifi or

iPad Air 2, 32GB, wifi

****We do not encourage Sim cards as non-school networks can be accessed***

Can a different non-Apple tablet be used?

No. Based on available tech support (2 days p/week) we have made the decision to streamline with Apple products

Is the program an option?

It is an expectation that all students in grade 5 and 6 have a device from 2017.

Do we buy the device through the school?

No. Devices need to be purchased by families at a vendor of their choosing.

Parents will receive a 4% discount on devices, and 10 % discount on accessories when they go to an Apple store and mention they are from Brighton Primary School as part of the **family funded project**.

Another alternative option may be to look at a **refurbished model from Apple** which can be considerably cheaper.

Are any accessories required?

Headphones/Earphones and a protective case are required. Keyboards are an option.

What apps are required?
