My child is due to start Prep in two years. When do I submit an enrolment form?

The school only accepts enrolments the year before the school entry year. Enrolment forms are available from the school office from Term 2.

Does the school accept enrolments during the course of the academic year (i.e. students arriving from overseas or interstate)?

Yes. Children who have already commenced school either overseas or in Australia and are moving into the Brighton Primary School zone, can be enrolled. Normal enrolment criteria applies. Students enrolling during the school year are given the opportunity to meet their teacher before commencing at Brighton Primary School. It is a requirement that students are in full school uniform on the day they commence.

I live outside the school zone. Can I enrol my child at Brighton Primary School?

On receipt of a completed Out-of-Zone Enrolment Form your child will be placed on a waiting list. The waiting list opens the year before the school entry year. Forms are available from the school office from Term 2 (after the Easter break). Out-of-Zone places will not be offered before September.

What language other than English is taught at Brighton Primary School?

Brighton Primary School is an International School and offers students an introduction to two languages: Italian and Mandarin Chinese. Students from Prep to Grade four will be introduced to Italian and students in Grades five and six will be introduced to Mandarin Chinese.

What are the school fees and how are they allocated to programs?

The School Council of Brighton Primary decides on the school payment structure (Parent Contributions) each year. Currently the schedule is as follows:

Essential Education Items (compulsory):

(Includes Stationery items, Materials for Programs and Life Education): \$430

Optional Items

Prep – Grade 4: Excursions and activities \$125
(Camps and Swimming to be billed separately as the programs are delivered)

Grades 5 - 6: Excursions and activities \$150
(Camps, Swimming, Lifesaving, Bike Education and School Sports to be billed separately as the programs are delivered).

Grade 6 Graduation \$ 25

Voluntary Contributions:

(Supports the School Nurse, maintenance of ICT facilities and grounds development)
