<p>Who participates in the program?</p> <p>Students in grade 5 and 6.</p>	<p>When does it start?</p> <p>Start of Term 1 2018</p>
<p>What device is required?</p> <p>An Apple iPad, iPad Air, iPad Pro or iPad Mini with the following capabilities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Runs the most up-to-date apple ios software -Enough available memory to create a range of media and download required apps -Working camera <p>This chart provides device specific information http://iossupportmatrix.com/</p> <p>As base model purchase we recommend: iPad Pro 10.5 inch wifi 64GB or 256 GB or iPad 9.7 inch, 32GB or 128GB, wifi or iPad mini 4, 128GB, wifi <i>*We do not encourage Sim cards as non-school networks can be accessed</i></p>	<p>Do we buy the device through the school?</p> <p>No. Devices need to be purchased by families at a vendor of their choosing.</p> <p>We have worked with both JB Hi-Fi and Apple to secure some discounts.</p> <p>JB Hi-Fi (Online purchase, approx 2 weeks delivery)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Go to jbeducation.com.au/byod 2. Enter School Code: Brighton2018 4. Once logged in, select 'From 5 to 6' program 5. Choose your nominated JB Hi-Fi store for pickup. 6. Follow the prompts, enter your details, then choose your products, insurance and accessories 7. Select a payment method and complete your pre-order 8. <p><i>Is the program an option?</i></p> <p>It is an expectation that all students in grade 5 and 6 have a device from 2018.</p>	<p><i>Can a different non-Apple tablet be used?</i></p> <p>No. Based on available tech support (2 days p/week) we have made the decision to streamline with Apple products.</p>
<p><i>Are any accessories required?</i></p> <p>Headphones/Earphones and a protective case are required. Keyboards are an option.</p>	<p><i>What apps are required?</i></p> <p>An 'Apps list' will be published on Compass at the start of Term 1, 2018. We mostly use free apps.</p>
