My child is due to start Prep in two years. When do I submit an enrolment form?

The school only accepts enrolments the year before the school entry year. Enrolment forms are available from the school office.

Does the school accept enrolments during the course of the academic year (i.e. students arriving from overseas or interstate)?

Yes. Children who have already commenced school either overseas or in Australia and are moving into the Brighton Primary School zone, can be enrolled. Normal enrolment criteria applies. Students enrolling during the school year are given the opportunity to meet their teacher before commencing at Brighton Primary School. It is a requirement that students are in full school uniform on the day they commence.

I live outside the school zone. Can I enrol my child at Brighton Primary School?

On receipt of a completed Enrolment Form your child will be placed on a waiting list. The waiting list opens the year before the school entry year. Forms are available from the school office. Out-of-Zone places will not be offered before August.

What language other than English is taught at Brighton Primary School?

Brighton Primary School is an international School and from 2016, we have offered students an introduction to French. This follows a consultation with existing families to align with high school language programs.
